STOCKPORT GRAMMAR SCHOOL SCHOOL FEE POLICY

As an independent School with charitable status, Stockport Grammar School receives no Government support and is dependent on fee income to cover its operating costs.

The Governors of the School are conscious of the significant burden of fees on many families who attend the school and each year they review the fees for the following academic year, mindful of their responsibility to ensure the continuing financial stability of the School and to ensure that the School remains well maintained and conducive to high levels of academic and extra-curricular achievement and pastoral support.

Annual fee increases are kept to a minimum consistent with the School's cost base, the recognition that the Governors wish to attract and retain the highest quality staff and the need to provide an operating surplus to allow continued investment in and development of the School's facilities.
