### REQUEST PERMISSION TO BRING A MOBILE PHONE TO SCHOOL

There are occasions when it is helpful for a child to have a mobile phone for use outside of school, for example, when using the school buses or for when a child is not collected directly from school. **Children who are collected from school do not need a mobile phone** as any phone calls which need to be made will be arranged by the relevant member of staff.

Please note that the use of mobile phones is not allowed within school **at any time** and you are asked to make your child aware of the rules relating to mobile phones within school, which are set out below. In cases where children are unable to meet these requirements, permission to bring a mobile phone into school may be withdrawn.
