School Council

The School Council meets once per term, chaired by the Deputy Head. In addition to the Head Boy, Head Girl and House Captains, one pupil from each form class is elected by their peers to represent the form class on the Council. Pupils are encouraged to discuss matters relating to non-curricular issues in school. The Deputy Head informs pupils of the meeting date and requests items for discussion to be prepared beforehand with the form class.

What are the aims of the school council?

- To make sure that our school is a safe and happy place for children.
- To make sure that children have a place to voice their concerns.
- To encourage all children in the school to suggest improvements.
- To make sure any suggestions or concerns are listened to and acted upon.

Minutes are displayed which also include a commentary/response from the Headmaster and Deputy Head and, if necessary, the Catering Manager and/or Bursar.

Two members of the School Council provide a report to the Governors' Education Committee along with an oral report to Full Board each summer.
