After hearing about the themes and processes Amang uses to produce his work, pupils were able to create their own piece in response to music by working 'directly' on to paper using charcoal and paint, and producing outcomes that were full of energy.

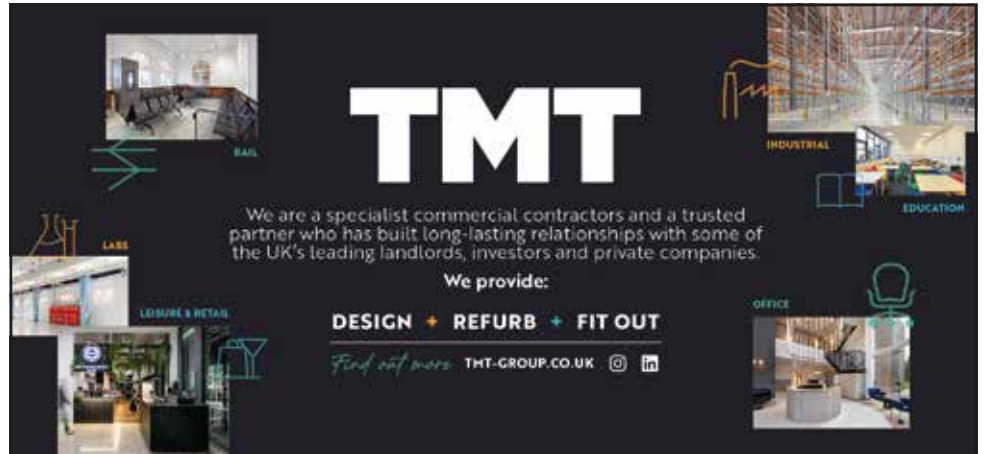
